Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in California for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 520,000 head on September 1, 2022. The inventory was 5% below last month and 2% below September 1, 2021. During August, placements in feedlots totaled 50,000 head, 4% below the previous year. Net placements were 43,000 head. Marketings of fed cattle during August totaled 68,000 head, 26% above August 2021. Other disappearance totaled 7,000 head during August, 13% below August 2021.

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 11.3 million head on September 1, 2022. The inventory was slightly above September 1, 2021. Placements in feedlots during August totaled 2.11 million head, slightly above 2021. Net placements were 2.06 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during August totaled 2.00 million head, 6% above 2021. Other disappearance totaled 53,000 head during August, 10% below 2021.
