November Milk Production in California down 1.7 percent

Milk production during November totaled 3.27 billion pounds, down 1.7 percent from November 2022 and down 1.3 percent from October 2023. The number of milk cows on farms in California was 1.71 million head, down 11,000 from November 2022 and unchanged from October 2023. Production per cow in California averaged 1,910 pounds, down 20 pounds from November 2022 and down 25 pounds from October 2023.


