## **CALIFORNIA EGG PRODUCTION**

California's egg production during June totaled 183 million, down 8.40 million from May's production and down 74.4 million from June 2023. The all layers during the month totaled 8.13 million, up 1 percent from last month, but down 27 percent from June 2023. Eggs per 100 layers during the month were 2,249, compared to 2,365 a month earlier, and 2,311 in June 2023.

### **U.S. JUNE EGG PRODUCTION**

United States egg production totaled 8.81 billion during June 2024, down 2 percent from last year. Production included 7.56 billion table eggs, and 1.25 billion hatching eggs, of which 1.15 billion were broiler-type and 96.7 million were egg-type. The average number of layers during June 2024 totaled 371 million, down 3 percent from last year. June egg production per 100 layers was 2,377 eggs, up 1 percent from June 2023.

All layers in the United States on July 1, 2024 totaled 370 million, down 3 percent from last year. The 370 million layers consisted of 305 million layers producing table or market type eggs, 61.2 million layers producing broiler-type hatching eggs, and 3.79 million layers producing egg-type hatching eggs. Rate of lay per day on July 1, 2024, averaged 79.1 eggs per 100 layers, up 1 percent from July 1, 2023.

### **U.S. EGG-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED**

Egg-type chicks hatched during June 2024 totaled 56.7 million, down 3 percent from June 2023. Eggs in incubators totaled 53.6 million on July 1, 2024, up 8 percent from a year ago.

Domestic placements of egg-type pullet chicks for future hatchery supply flocks by leading breeders totaled 219 thousand during June 2024, up 10 percent from June 2023.

### **U.S. BROILER-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED**

Broiler-type chicks hatched during June 2024 totaled 833 million, up slightly from June 2023. Eggs in incubators totaled 736 million on July 1, 2024, up 2 percent from a year ago.

Leading breeders placed 9.78 million broiler-type pullet chicks for future domestic hatchery supply flocks during June 2024, up 1 percent from June 2023.

#### **U.S. TURKEY HATCHERY PRODUCTION**

Turkey eggs in incubators on July 1, 2024, in the United States totaled 23.0 million, down 15 percent from July 1, 2023. Eggs in incubators were up 1 percent from the June 1, 2024 total of 22.8 million eggs.

Turkey poults hatched during June 2024, in the United States totaled 19.5 million, down 18 percent from June 2023. Poults hatched were down 10 percent from the May 2024 total of 21.7 million poults.

The 18.8 million net poults placed during June 2024 in the United States were down 18 percent from the number placed during the same month a year earlier. Net placements were down 9 percent from the May 2024 total of 20.6 million.
