CALIFORNIA EGG PRODUCTION

California's egg production during October totaled 205 million, up 6.10 million from September's production but down 55.5 million from October 2023. The all layers during the month totaled 8.53 million, down 3 percent from last month, and down 23 percent from October 2023. Eggs per 100 layers during the month were 2,401, compared to 2,256 a month earlier, and 2,355 in October 2023.

U.S. OCTOBER EGG PRODUCTION

United States egg production totaled 9.19 billion during October 2024, down 4 percent from last year. Production included 7.89 billion table eggs, and 1.30 billion hatching eggs, of which 1.21 billion were broiler-type and 92.4 million were egg-type. The average number of layers during October 2024 totaled 377 million, down 3 percent from last year. October egg production per 100 layers was 2,438 eggs, down 1 percent from October 2023.

All layers in the United States on November 1, 2024 totaled 377 million, down 3 percent from last year. The 377 million layers consisted of 312 million layers producing table or market type eggs, 61.2 million layers producing broiler-type hatching eggs, and 3.62 million layers producing egg-type hatching eggs. Rate of lay per day on November 1, 2024, averaged 78.8 eggs per 100 layers, down 1 percent from November 1, 2023.

U.S. EGG-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED

Egg-type chicks hatched during October 2024 totaled 54.9 million, up 7 percent from October 2023. Eggs in incubators totaled 49.3 million on November 1, 2024, up 5 percent from a year ago.

Domestic placements of egg-type pullet chicks for future hatchery supply flocks by leading breeders totaled 245 thousand during October 2024, down 2 percent from October 2023.

U.S. BROILER-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED

Broiler-type chicks hatched during October 2024 totaled 845 million, up 3 percent from October 2023. Eggs in incubators totaled 723 million on November 1, 2024, up 6 percent from a year ago.

Leading breeders placed 8.06 million broiler-type pullet chicks for future domestic hatchery supply flocks during October 2024, up 1 percent from October 2023.

U.S. TURKEY HATCHERY PRODUCTION

Turkey eggs in incubators on November 1, 2024, in the United States totaled 25.0 million, down 2 percent from November 1, 2023. Eggs in incubators were up slightly from the October 1, 2024 total of 24.9 million eggs.

Turkey poults hatched during October 2024, in the United States totaled 20.7 million, down 9 percent from October 2023. Poults hatched were up 2 percent from the September 2024 total of 20.2 million poults.

The 18.8 million net poults placed during October 2024 in the United States were down 9 percent from the number placed during the same month a year earlier. Net placements were up 5 percent from the September 2024 total of 17.9 million.
