## KANSAS HONEY PRODUCTION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. March 17, 2023** - Honey production in 2022 from Kansas producers with five or more colonies totaled 372,000 pounds, up 27% from 2021, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

There were 6,000 honey producing colonies in Kansas during 2022, down 14% from 2021. Average yield was 62 pounds per colony, up 20 pounds from 2021. Producer stocks were 167,000 pounds on December 15, 2022, up from 144,000 pounds a year earlier.

Prices for the 2022 crop averaged \$3.65 per pound, up from \$3.07 per pound in 2021. Prices were based on retail sales by producers and sales to private processors and cooperatives. Total value of honey produced in 2022 was \$1.36 million up 50% from 2021.
