2022 Louisiana Total Value of Production for Field Crops Up 13 Percent

The value of production for field crops in Louisiana during 2022 totaled \$2.92 billion, up 13 percent from 2021. The top three crop commodities (excluding sugarcane), soybeans, corn, and rice, accounted for 59 percent of the total value of production for field crops. Cotton seed showed the largest increase at 163 percent in value of production from last year, followed by cotton at 68 percent. Corn showed the largest percentage decrease from 2021 at 10 percent.

At the national level, the value of production for field crops was up 3 percent, at \$219 billion, from 2021. Corn, at \$91.7 billion, was the leading field crop followed by soybeans at \$61.1 billion and all hay at \$21.3 billion.




