2022 Louisiana Honey Production Up 19 Percent

Honey production during 2022 from Louisiana producers with five or more colonies totaled 2.56 million pounds, up 19 percent from 2021. There were 42,000 honey producing colonies in 2022, up 5,000 colonies from previous year. Yield per colony averaged 61 pounds of honey, up 5 percent from 2021. Honey stocks held by producers on December 15, 2022, were 487,000 pounds, up 183 percent from a year earlier. The average price for honey decreased from \$2.49 per pound in 2021 to \$2.47 per pound in 2022. The total value of honey production totaled \$6.33 million, up 18 percent from the previous year.

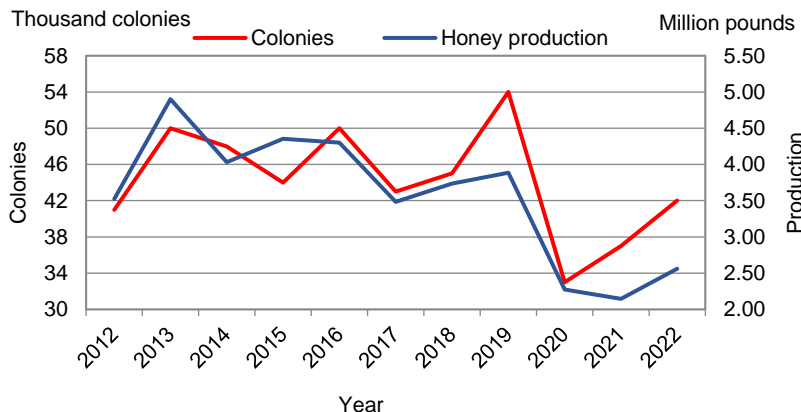
