Broiler-Type Eggs Set Down 1 Percent from Last Year

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.24 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending January 28, 2023, down 1 percent from the comparable week in 2022 but up slightly from the previous week.

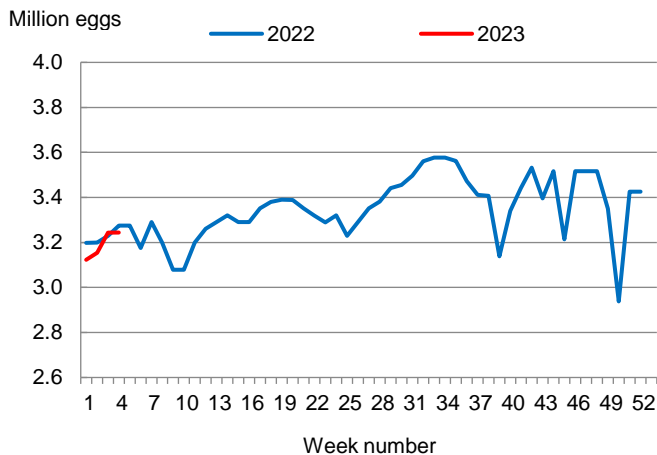
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 239 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 28, 2023, down slightly from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Down 5 Percent

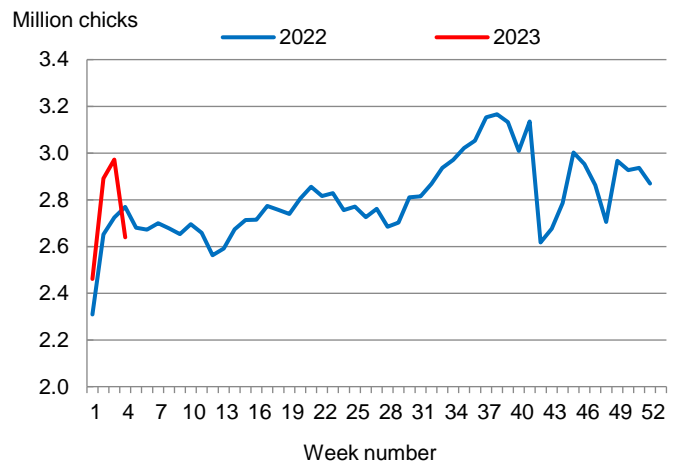
Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.64 million chicks during the week ending January 28, 2023, down 5 percent from the comparable week in 2022 and down 11 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 188 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 28, 2023, up 1 percent from a year ago.
