#### **Broiler-Type Eggs Set Down 16 Percent from Last Year**


Louisiana hatcheries set 2.93 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending August 5, 2023, down 16 percent from the comparable week in 2022 but unchanged from the previous week.


Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 242 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 5, 2023, down 1 percent from a year ago.

#### **Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 3 Percent**


Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.89 million chicks during the week ending August 5, 2023, up 3 percent from the comparable week in 2022 and up 7 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 188 million chicks for meat production during the week ending August 5, 2023, down slightly from a year ago.
