Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 7 Percent from Last Year

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.53 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending March 2, 2024, up 7 percent from the comparable week in 2023 and up 2 percent from the previous week.

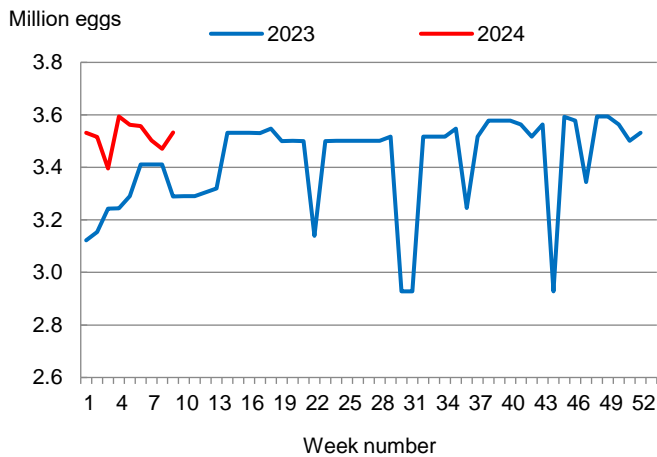
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 243 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 2, 2024, up slightly from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 1 Percent

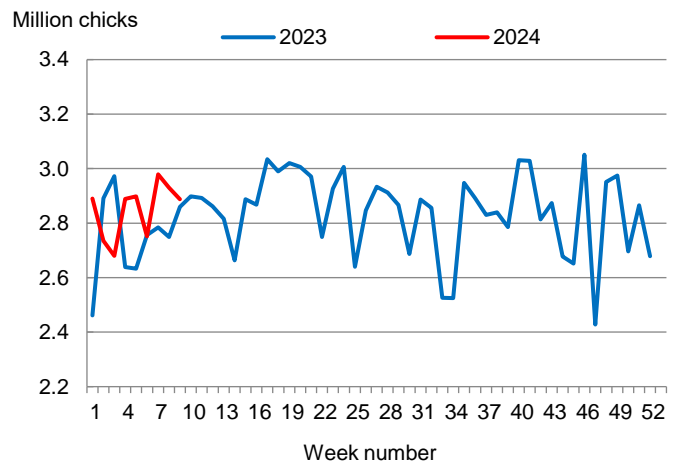
Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.89 million chicks during the week ending March 2, 2024, up 1 percent from the comparable week in 2023 but down 1 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending March 2, 2024, down slightly from a year ago.
