#### **Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 3 Percent from Last Year**


Louisiana hatcheries set 3.61 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending August 17, 2024, up 3 percent from the comparable week in 2023 but unchanged from the previous week.

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 249 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 17, 2024, up 4 percent from a year ago.


### **Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 18 Percent**

Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.99 million chicks during the week ending August 17, 2024, up 18 percent from the comparable week in 2023 and up 2 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 193 million chicks for meat production during the week ending August 17, 2024, up 3 percent from a year ago.
