#### **Broiler-Type Eggs Set Down 6 Percent from Last Year**


Louisiana hatcheries set 3.37 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending November 9, 2024, down 6 percent from the comparable week in 2023 and down 3 percent from the previous week.


Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 239 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 9, 2024, up 1 percent from a year ago.

### **Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 9 Percent**

Louisiana broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 2.89 million chicks during the week ending November 9, 2024, up 9 percent from the comparable week in 2023 but down 1 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 186 million chicks for meat production during the week ending November 9, 2024, up 5 percent from a year ago.
