United States Commercial Slaughter

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 4.78 billion pounds in December 2021, down 1 percent from the 4.86 billion pounds produced in December 2020.

Beef production, at 2.36 billion pounds, was 1 percent above the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 2.82 million head, up 1 percent from December 2020.

Veal production totaled 5.30 million pounds, 7 percent below December a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 38,700 head, down 5 percent from December 2020.

Pork production totaled 2.40 billion pounds, down 4 percent from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 11.1 million head, down 4 percent from December 2020.

Lamb and mutton production, at 11.6 million pounds, was down 4 percent from December 2020. Sheep slaughter totaled 187,100 head, 5 percent below last year.

Pacific Region Commercial Slaughter

California's production of red meat during December 2021 totaled 145 million pounds (dressed weight), 5 percent below than December 2020. This figure includes slaughter in Federally-inspected and state-inspected plants, but excludes farm slaughter. In December 2021, the average live weight of cattle slaughtered in California was 1,348 pounds, calves averaged 127 pounds, sheep and lambs averaged 139 pounds, and hogs averaged 254 pounds. In Hawaii, 900,000 pounds of red meat were produced in December 2021, and 100,000 pounds of red meat were produced in Nevada.
