United States Commercial Slaughter

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 4.43 billion pounds in February 2022, up 1 percent from the 4.39 billion pounds produced in February 2021.

Beef production, at 2.25 billion pounds, was 7 percent above the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 2.69 million head, up 6 percent from February 2021.

Veal production totaled 4.2 million pounds, 10 percent below February a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 30,400 head, down 8 percent from February 2021.

Pork production totaled 2.17 billion pounds, down 4 percent from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 9.94 million head, down 5 percent from February 2021.

Lamb and mutton production, at 9.2 million pounds, was down 14 percent from February 2021. Sheep slaughter totaled 143,400 head, 12 percent below last year.

Pacific Region Commercial Slaughter

California's production of red meat during February 2022 totaled 139.2 million pounds (dressed weight), down 3 percent from February 2021. This figure includes slaughter in Federally-inspected and state-inspected plants, but excludes farm slaughter. In February 2022, the average live weight of cattle slaughtered in California was 1,348 pounds, calves averaged 128 pounds, sheep and lambs averaged 149 pounds, and hogs averaged 263 pounds. In Hawaii, 0.8 million pounds of red meat were produced in February 2022, and 0.1 million pounds of red meat were produced in Nevada.
