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United States Commercial Slaughter

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 4.83 billion pounds in August 2022, up 5 percent from the 4.59 billion pounds produced in August 2021.

Beef production, at 2.51 billion pounds, was 6 percent above the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 3.08 million head, up 7 percent from August 2021.

Veal production totaled 4.70 million pounds, 9 percent above August a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 33,900 head, down 2 percent from August 2021.

Pork production totaled 2.30 billion pounds, up 4 percent from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 11.0 million head, up 3 percent from August 2021.

Lamb and mutton production, at 11.7 million pounds, was up 13 percent from August 2021. Sheep slaughter totaled 182,000 head, 2 percent above last year.

Pacific Region Commercial Slaughter

California's production of red meat during August 2022 totaled 154 million pounds (dressed weight), 6 percent above August 2021. This figure includes slaughter in Federally-inspected and state-inspected plants, but excludes farm slaughter. In August 2022, the average live weight of cattle slaughtered in California was 1,312 pounds, calves averaged 134 pounds, sheep and lambs averaged 152 pounds, and hogs averaged 255 pounds. In Hawaii, 1,000,000 pounds of red meat were produced in August 2022.
