Milk production in **New York** during October 2023 totaled 1.35 billion pounds, up 2.1 percent from October 2022. The average milk price received by New York farmers in September 2023, at \$21.90 per hundredweight, is \$1.40 higher than August 2023 but \$4.10 lower than September a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during October 2023 totaled 806 million pounds, down 0.5 percent from October 2022. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in September 2023, at \$21.50 per hundredweight, is \$1.30 higher than August 2023 but \$4.60 lower than September a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during October 2023 totaled 209 million pounds, down 1.4 percent from October 2022. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in September 2023, at \$22.20 per hundredweight, is \$1.30 higher than August 2023 but \$4.20 lower than September a year ago.
