Milk production in **New York** during January 2022 totaled 1.305 million pounds, down 0.6 percent from December 2021. The average milk price received by New York farmers in December 2022, at \$22.00 per hundredweight, is up \$0.70 from November 2022 but up \$3.70 from November a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during January 2022 totaled 849 million pounds, down 2.9 percent from December 2021. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in December 2022, at \$22.30 per hundredweight, is up \$0.80 from November 2022 and up \$3.50 from November a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during January 2022 totaled 216 million pounds, down 1.8 percent from December 2021. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in December 2022, at \$22.70 per hundredweight, is up \$1.00 from November 2022 and \$3.70 from November a year ago.
