Milk production in **New York** during March 2022 totaled 1,327 million pounds, down 0.1 percent from March 2021. The average milk price received by New York farmers in February 2022, at \$25.40 per hundredweight, is up \$0.70 from January 2022 and up \$8.00 from February a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during March 2022 totaled 873 million pounds, down 2.2 percent from March 2021. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in February 2022, at \$25.70 per hundredweight, is up \$0.90 from January 2022 and up \$8.30 from February a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during March 2022 totaled 221 million pounds, down 0.9 percent from March 2021. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in February 2022, at \$26.00 per hundredweight, is up \$ 0.80 from January 2022 and up \$8.10 from February a year ago.
