Milk production in **New York** during November 2022 totaled 1.28 billion pounds, up 3.2 percent from November 2021. The average milk price received by New York farmers in October 2022, at \$26.70 per hundredweight, is up \$0.70 from September 2022 and up \$6.80 from October a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during November 2022 totaled 801 million pounds, unchanged from November 2021. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in October 2022, at \$26.90 per hundredweight, is up \$0.80 from September 2022 and up \$7.00 from October a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during November 2022 totaled 207 million pounds, up 1.5 percent from November 2021. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in October 2022, at \$27.00 per hundredweight, is up \$0.60 from September 2022 and up \$6.70 from October a year ago.
