New York corn acreage at a ten year high; winter wheat planted up 21%

ALBANY, NY --- New York **corn** planted area for all purposes in 2023 is estimated at 1.13 million acres, up 10% from 2022, according to Charles Walker, state statistician for USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS), New York Field Office. Growers expect to harvest 650 thousand acres for corn grain.

New York **soybean** planted area this year is estimated at a record high 355 thousand acres planted, up 1% from 2022.

New York **barley** seeded area is estimated at 9 thousand acres, unchanged from 2022.

New York **winter wheat** acreage planted is estimated at 170 thousand, up 21% from 2022. New York winter wheat harvested acreage is forecast to be 155 thousand.
