Milk production in **New York** during January 2023 totaled 1.34 billion pounds, up 3.5 percent from January 2022. The average milk price received by New York farmers in December 2022, at \$24.90 per hundredweight, is down \$1.10 from November 2022 but up \$2.90 from December a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during January 2023 totaled 848 million pounds, up 0.1 percent from January 2022. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in December 2022, at \$25.50 per hundredweight, is down \$1.10 from November 2022 but up \$3.20 from December a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during January 2023 totaled 218 million pounds, up 0.9 percent from January 2022. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in December 2022, at \$25.40 per hundredweight, is down \$0.90 from November 2022 but up \$2.70 from December a year ago.
