Milk production in **New York** during March 2023 totaled 1.36 billion pounds, up 2.1 percent from March 2022. The average milk price received by New York farmers in February 2023, at \$22.50 per hundredweight, is down \$1.20 from January 2023 and down \$2.90 from February a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during March 2023 totaled 871 million pounds, down 0.2 percent from March 2022. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in February 2023, at \$22.70 per hundredweight, is down \$1.20 from January 2023 and down \$3.00 from February a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during March 2023 totaled 219 million pounds, down 0.9 percent from March 2022. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in February 2023, at \$23.00 per hundredweight, is down \$1.10 from January 2023 and down \$3.00 from February a year ago.
