Meat Animal Cash Receipts

Ohio cattle and calves cash receipts totaled \$606.6 million in 2021, up 2 percent from 2020, according to Cheryl Turner, State Statistician of the USDA, NASS, Ohio Field Office. Cattle and calf marketings totaled 559.5 million pounds, down 8 percent from 2020.

Ohio hog cash receipts totaled \$933.1 million in 2021, up 34 percent from 2020. All hog and pig marketings totaled 1.4 billion pounds in 2021, down 3 percent from the previous year.

Nationally, cash receipts from marketings of cattle and calves increased 16 percent, from \$63.1 billion in 2020 to \$72.9 billion in 2021. All cattle and calf marketings totaled 61.4 billion pounds in 2021, up 4 percent from 2020.

Nationally, cash receipts from hogs and pigs totaled \$28.0 billion during 2021, up 46 percent from 2020. Marketings totaled 41.8 billion pounds in 2021, down slightly from 2020.
