This report contains the results from the September 2022 Hog and Pig Survey. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available December 23, 2022.

Oklahoma Highlights

The September 1, 2022 Oklahoma hog and pig inventory, at 2.26 million head, was 3 percent higher than September 2021. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 510 thousand head, up 40 thousand from last year. The September 1 **market hog** inventory was up 1 percent from a year ago at 1.75 million head, 77 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.


The June 2022-August 2022 Oklahoma **pig crop** totaled 2.19 million head, 1 percent above last year. Pigs per litter averaged 10.2, down 6 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during June 2022 through August 2022 totaled 215 thousand head, up 8 percent from last year.

Texas Highlights

The September 1, 2022 Texas hog and pig inventory, at 1.19 million head, was 9 percent higher than September 2021. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 170 thousand head, up 30 thousand from last year. The September 1 **market hog** inventory was up 7 percent from a year ago at 1.02 million head, 86 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.

The June 2022-August 2022 Texas **pig crop** totaled 714 thousand head, 7 percent below last year. Pigs per litter averaged 9.4, down 15 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during June 2022 through August 2022 totaled 76.0 thousand head, up 10 percent from last year.





U.S. Highlights

The U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs on September 1, 2022, is estimated at 73.8 million head, down 1 percent from a year ago but up 2 percent from June 1, 2022. The **breeding hog inventory**, at 6.15 million head, was down 1 percent from last year and down slightly from the previous quarter. **Market hog** inventory, at 67.6 million head, was down 1 percent from last year but up 2 percent from last quarter.

The U.S. **pig crop** for June 2022-August 2022, at 33.6 million, was down 1 percent from 2021. U.S. producers intend to have 2.97 million sows farrow during the September 2022-November 2022 period, down 2 percent from the actual farrowings during the same period last year. Intended farrowings for December 2022-February 2023, at 2.90 million sows, are down 1 percent from the same quarter the year prior.
