This report contains the 2024 intended wheat seedings for the Southern Plains region resulting from data collected during the December 2023 Agriculture Survey. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the December Agriculture Survey, your responses are the foundation of these estimates for the Southern Plains.

Oklahoma seedings for the 2024 wheat crop are forecast at 4.30 million acres, down 5 percent from last year. Canola seedings were estimated at 30.0 thousand, up 1000 percent from last year.

Texas seedings for the 2024 wheat crop are forecast at 5.90 million acres, down 8 percent from last year.


