This report contains information on prices and values of production for major field crops and many specialty crops. All prices in this report are marketing year average prices, which are based on sales in the months comprising each commodity's marketing year. State-level value of production is computed by multiplying each state's price by its production.



US Value of Production for Field and Miscellaneous Crops down 12 Percent in 2023

The United States value of production for field and miscellaneous crops was estimated at \$191 billion in 2023, down 12 percent from 2022. Alabama's value of field and miscellaneous crop production totaled \$1.14 billion, down 15 percent from the previous year. At \$278 million, Alabama's leading value of crop production was corn for grain. The value of Florida's field and miscellaneous crop production totaled \$1.44 billion, a 3 percent increase from 2022. The value of Georgia's field and miscellaneous crop production was estimated at \$2.54 billion, a decrease of 15 percent from the previous year. The leading crop production value for Georgia was cotton at \$868 million. Field and miscellaneous crop values in South Carolina totaled \$908 million, an 8 percent decrease from 2022. The value of corn for grain, at \$286 million, represented the largest value for South Carolina.
