The estimates in this report are based primarily on the December 2023 Agricultural Survey which was conducted during the first two weeks of December. The estimates provided in this report are intended to reflect grower plantings for the 2024 crop year. These estimates will not be revised; instead, new estimates will be made throughout the growing season as additional survey data and administrative data are received. U.S. winter wheat seeded area for 2024 is expected to total 34.4 million acres, down 6 percent from 2023. Alabama seedings are estimated at 160,000 acres, down 22 percent from the previous year. Georgia seedings are estimated at 190,000 acres, down 3 percent from 2023. South Carolina seedings are estimated at 100,000 acres, down 9 percent from the previous year.
