
COMMERCIAL FERTILIZER

Commercial fertilizer sales in South Dakota in 2012, (based on preliminary data) showed 2,106,348 tons (including carrier material) sold. Actual nutrients (NPK) totaled 980,326 tons. Nitrogen accounted for 65 percent of the total NPK, phosphorus (P_2O_5) accounted for 26 percent, and potassium (K_2O) accounted for 9 percent.

The fertilizer 46-0-0 was the most widely used analysis again in 2012, with 891,166 tons sold. The second most popular was 11-52-0, with 239,196 tons, and the third choice was 28-0-0 with 172,220 tons. These three accounted for 62 percent of all fertilizer sold in South Dakota in 2012.
