COST OF POLLINATION SURVEY RESULTS

LINCOLN, Neb. January 11, 2023 - The U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Agricultural Statistics Service has released the results of its 2022 *Cost of Pollination* survey. The survey, conducted in all 50 states, was sent to 16,000 operations nationally and collected information on acres pollinated, colonies used, and dollars spent for a variety of different crops. The target population was all farms and ranches with at least one acre of a crop determined to be potentially pollinated by honey bees.
