# Wisconsin Ag News – Monthly Prices

The average price received by farmers for corn during September 2024 in Wisconsin was \$3.70 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service - Agricultural Prices report. This was 3 cents below the August price and \$1.37 below September 2023.

The September 2024 average price received by farmers for soybeans, at \$10.20 per bushel, was 30 cents below the August price and \$3.50 below the September 2023 price.

The September average oat price per bushel, at \$3.11, was 6 cents below August and 85 cents below September 2023.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$123.00 per ton in September. This was \$5.00 below the August price but \$10.00 above the September 2023 price. The September 2024 alfalfa hay price, at \$132.00, was \$7.00 below the previous month and \$42.00 below September 2023. The average price received for other hay during September was \$97.00 per ton. This was unchanged from the August price but \$16.00 below September last year.

The average price for milk was \$25.50 per cwt, \$2.50 above the August price and \$5.40 above September 2023. Prices received for milk cows for dairy herd replacement averaged \$2,850 per head as of October 1, 2024.


