Certified Organic Highlights

The 2016 Certified Organic Survey is a survey of all operations identified as having certified organic production. Certified organic farms must meet the standards set out by USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service's (AMS) National Organic Program (NOP) and be certified compliant by an approved agent of NOP. Results from the survey provide acreage, production, and sales data for a variety of certified organic crops and certified organic livestock.

In 2016, the United States had 14,217 certified organic farms that produced \$7.6 billion in certified organic products. Rhode Island had 25 certified organic farms that produced \$2.3 million in certified organic products. There were 137 acres of certified land in Rhode Island. The top two certified commodities sold in Rhode Island were other vegetables and fresh herbs grown under protection with sales valued at \$726,100 and tomatoes grown under protection with sales valued at \$235,200.
